## **MONDAY PROGRAMS**

### **Art – Drawing and Painting (Artistic Way)**

Grades: 1-6

Cost: \$126

Min/Max: 6/18

For kids who love to draw and paint, or those who would like to learn how. This course introduces the basics of drawing; visual perception, techniques, materials and the creative thought process. We'll touch on still life, portraiture, cartooning and abstract themes, and will explore both black/white and colour. (Materials included)

Grades: 2-6

At the Director's Cut, you become the author, digital illustrator, digital photographer and creator in our all star workshop Comic Relief! Using our digital cameras, lap top computers, expert super hero instruction and your imagination, you along with your cast of sidekicks will create your idea, take digital pictures, edit them and then comicfy yourselves, creating a one of a kind, published comic book that may make Stan Lee get a little nervous! ### **Guitar (Snider School of Music)**

Grades: 4-6

### **Tennis (Lytton Park Tennis)**

Grades: 1-4

Cost: \$145

Min/Max: 8/24

## TUESDAY PROGRAMS

### **Chess (Chess 'n Math Association)**

Grades: 1-6

Cost: \$90

Min/Max: 12/24

Lessons are tailored for beginner to advanced students and each lesson is followed by a practice session. Certificates indicating the level achieved are awarded at the end of each course. Math and strategy - the best part is children learn through play! Kids who participated last session will build from where they left off.

### **Hip Hop Dance (The Kids Fun Factory)**

Grades: 1-6

Cost: \$115

Min/Max: 8/18

This is a trendy choice for children who want dance skills, fun, and fitness. Participants will learn balance, flexibility, and coordination while doing age-appropriate, stylish routines. Each week they will develop hip-hop skills and build them into routines and improvisation. A performance will take place during the last class.

### **St. John Ambulance Babysitting - 6 weeks (Pat Cook)**

Grades: 6 (age 11+)

Cost: \$100

Min/Max: 10/20

A course designed to teach babysitting, leadership and First-Aid skills in a fun, informative way. Students learn how to care for infants, toddlers and older children, what questions to ask parents, how to give First Aid, and what to do in emergencies. Activity book activities, role-playing and hands-on practice teach skills and build confidence. Each student will receive a copy of an award winning publication, 'What Every Babysitter Should Know' workbook, and upon successful completion, a St John Ambulance Babysitter's attendance certificate.

### **Woodworking – Catapult Club (The Kids Fun Factory) **NEW!****

Grades: 4-6

Cost: \$118

Min/Max: 10/20

Build your own motorized Catapult with components including gears, wood, battery packs, and an electromagnetic motor. Gain confidence in applying scientific theories learned in school to a really cool take-home project. Armed with hands on knowledge of electricity, gears, levers, locomotion and aerodynamics, you will build a real battery powered car, that doubles as a Catapult. Each week, the instructor will introduce a specific design innovation for the vehicle and challenge the student teams to independently plan and incorporate the new feature into their model. Woodworking promotes a cooperative learning adventure that's exciting, challenging, educational and fun!

## WEDNESDAY PROGRAMS

### **Acting and Improv (Lori Pearlstein's Playworks)**

Grades: 1-5

Cost: \$115

Min/Max: 5/14

This class offers born performers and children who need to break out of their shell a chance to express themselves. In the world of Improv, there are no "lead" roles. Everyone is on the same playing field. Whether they're playing Second City/Who's Line is it Anyway style games, or creating bullying prevention through play, they learn how to think quickly on their feet, and build self esteem. Boys and girls are empowered by what they discover about themselves, they have a blast, and acquire valuable life skills at the same time!

### **Mad Science – World of Wowology (Mad Science of Toronto) NEW!**

Grades: 1-6

Cost: \$129

Min/Max: 12/20

Examining the world children interact with is an ideal way to explain complex scientific principles. Students will learn all about the science of flight and the forces that are involved in the process. Children will discover the basic scientific principles of magic and see how almost everything can be logically explained. Their reasoning skills will be put to the test as they become Junior Engineers, building and testing magnificent structures! We explore the amazing properties of water in a class called Wacky Waves, which is always a "splashing" success.

**Topics:** Che-Mystery, Current Events, Fundamental Forces, Science of Magic, Stunt Planes, Super Structures, Under Pressure, Wacky Waves.

### **Stop Motion Claymation (The Director's Cut)**

# APA AFTER 4 PROGRAM REGISTRATION INFORMATION

## Conditions of Registration and Participation

- It is understood that the Toronto District School Board, Allenby Parents' Association or any member of its administrative staff, cannot be held responsible in case of an accident during these activities. All reasonable precautions to ensure the safety of participants will be taken.
- Enrollment is based on a first-come, first served basis. Your child's enrollment will be confirmed by email (or by phone if no email).
- All registration fees are non-refundable.
- The minimum and maximum numbers are listed for each program. Waiting lists will be made for full classes.
- Due to congestion in the hallways students are asked to make their way directly to the workshop classroom in which their class is held at 3:35 pm where attendance will be taken.
- Grade 1 students will meet Jamie in the school office and she will escort them to the workshop classroom for the first 2 sessions. By the 3<sup>rd</sup> week, the grade 1's will make their way to the workshop classrooms independently.
- **It is the responsibility of the parent to inform the school if a child will NOT be attending an After 4 class. Please notify Jamie in the school AVP office at 416 393-9114 ext. 1 of any absences or changes in arrangements.**
- Every attempt will be made to contact the parent in the event that the child does not show up for class. Please leave alternate contact numbers.
- The After 4 Behaviour Code will be strictly enforced. If a child is asked to sit out in the office more than twice, he/she will **NOT** be allowed to continue in the session. ***Misbehaviour before, during, or after class could result in exclusion from further classes with no refunds given.***
- **Parents/caregivers are asked to pick up their child outside the library promptly at 4:45 pm. If parents/caregivers are late (after 5:00 pm) more than once, the child will no longer be allowed to attend the course. This policy will be strictly enforced. Please note the dismissal procedure: For safety purposes students must enter the Library and Jamie must check them off the attendance list before they can be released to parents/caregivers. Please be patient! Students who have permission to walk home on their own must check out with Jamie first. Jamie will escort the Daycare students to the Daycare.**
