PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

MONDAY PROGRAMS

Chess

Grades: 1-6

Cost: \$80

Monday (7 weeks) – Room 210

Min/Max: 12/24

The chess lessons are conducted by the Chess 'n' Math Association (CMA). Lessons are tailored for beginner to advanced students and each lesson is followed by a practice session. Certificates indicating the level achieved are awarded at the end of each course. Math and strategy - the best part is children learn through play!

Woodworking

Grades: 3-6

Cost: \$114.50

Monday (7 weeks) – Basement hallway

Min/Max: 10/15

Offers unparalleled exploration into the world of motorized machines and using basic woodworking tools. Watch the students apply scientific theories while constructing an impressive take-home project (this term, it is a bridge model). Armed with the principles of electricity, gears, levers, locomotion and aerodynamics, each child will build various projects.

Flamenco Dancing

Grades: 4-6

Cost: \$115

Monday (7 weeks) - Gym

Min/Max: 10/15

This is a movement and music class that teaches students expressive movement in the flamenco style. Students will learn rhythm through fun games and group work.

Rhythmic Gymnastics

Grades: 1-3

Cost: \$80

Monday (7 weeks) - Gym

Min/Max: 6/20

Combine the joy and benefits of gymnastics, dance, ballet and expressive movement and music - add rope, ribbon, hoop and ball apparatus - and you've got the beautiful and athletic sport of rhythmic gymnastics. Rhythmic Gymnastics is an Olympic sport

exclusive to girls that has elements of superior flexibility and coordination in conjunction with music and the use of apparatus. Come and learn in a fun and encouraging environment! Program fee includes a ball, rope and ribbon to keep.

TUESDAY PROGRAMS

Jewelry Making

Grades: 1-6

Cost: \$125.50

Tuesday (8 weeks) – Room 101

Min/Max: 6/20

Necklaces, Bracelets, Rings, Earrings – the possibilities are endless! Using a variety of materials, you will learn many new techniques to make beautiful jewelry pieces each week.

First Aid

Grades: 4-6

Cost: \$115

Tuesday (8 weeks) – Library

Min/Max: 6/20

Learn how to prevent injuries and to think, react and improvise in emergency situations. Practical hands-on components are supported by a variety of training materials, based on course requirements.

WEDNESDAY PROGRAMS

Mad Science – System 2

Grades: 1-6

Cost: \$105

Wednesday (8 weeks) – Room 210

Min/Max: 12/20

Students will not believe their eyes as they examine different optical illusions and watch as light and colour interact, tricking their sense of sight. Children will participate in classes where their taste buds are put to the test - they will learn how their sense of taste works. Studying the scientific principles of heat, students build their own thermometer. Students will learn all about magnets and how they are used in our everyday lives. The basics of sound will be revealed with a cool Mad Science twist - children's voices will be wildly distorted through a Mad Science sound machine. We will wow them with polymers in one of the most popular Mad Science Programs - Mad Science Putty!!! Educational, entertaining and sticky...what more could a kid wish for?

Topics: Watts-Up, Magnetic Magic, Optical Illusions, Lights...Colour...Action, Matter of Fact, Sonic Sound, Tantalizing Taste, Harnessing Heat.

Art – Time Travel

Grades: 1-6

Cost: \$115

Min/Max: 6/12

Tour art from prehistoric to contemporary times while making your own art works using images from art history and appropriate artists' tools and methods. This hands-on studio class is designed to give young artists an appreciation and understanding of art history in a fun and creative way.

THURSDAY PROGRAMS

Baking Bonanza

Grades: 1-4

Thursday (8 weeks) – Staff room (2nd floor)

Cost: \$120

Min/Max: 6/12

Each week the kids will participate in fun and interesting **NUT FREE** cooking projects. All children benefit from spending time in the kitchen. With our easy to follow recipes and other fun projects, kids are introduced to basic math skills, reading and comprehension. You will learn how to decorate your own cupcakes, make waffles from scratch, make lasagnas and make cookie dough to bring home and bake with your family!

Sewing

Grades: 1-6

Thursday (8 weeks) – Room 101

Cost: \$125.50

Min/Max: 6/20

In this fun course students will learn simple hand sewing techniques to create a variety of projects and repair clothing using various stitches and materials. The project ideas are endless!

Yoga Party

Grades: 3-6

Thursday (8 weeks) - Library

Cost: \$80

Min/Max: 10/25

Yoga Party will capture kids' imagination as they pretend to be cobras, bears, bugs and bridges through fun, interactive storytelling and song! Kids will have tons of fun learning a natural way to relax and focus while building strength and coordination. Kids will need to bring their own yoga mat.

Playworks: Acting and Improv Games

Grades: 2-6

Thursday (8 weeks) – Room 210

Cost: \$98

Min/Max: 5/12

In the world on Improv, there are no “lead” roles. Everyone is on the same playing field. This class offers born performers and children who need to break out of their shell, a chance to express themselves. Whether they're playing fun “Second City/Who's Line is it Anyway” style games or creating bullying prevention through play, they learn how to think quickly on their feet, and build self esteem. Boys and girls are empowered by what they discover about themselves, they have a blast, and they acquire valuable life skills at the same time!

ALLENBY AFTER 4 PROGRAMS REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Conditions of Registration and Participation

- It is understood that the Toronto District School Board, Allenby Parents' Association or any member of its administrative staff, cannot be held responsible in case of an accident during these activities. All reasonable precautions to ensure the safety of participants will be taken.
- Enrollment is based on a first-come, first served basis. You will be notified by email (or by phone if no email) by **April 18th**.
- All registration fees are non-refundable.
- The minimum and maximum numbers are listed for each program. Waiting lists will be made for full classes.
- Due to congestion in the hallways students are asked to make their way directly to the workshop classroom in which their class is held at 3:35 pm where attendance will be taken.
- Grade 1 students will meet Jamie by the school office and she will escort them to the workshop classroom for the first 2 sessions. By the 3rd week, the grade 1's will make their way to the workshop classrooms independently.
- **It is the responsibility of the parent** to inform the school if a child will **NOT** be attending an After 4 class. Please notify Jamie in the school AVP office at 416 393-9114 ext. 1 of any absences or changes in arrangements.
- Every attempt will be made to contact the parent in the event that the child does not show up for class. Please leave alternate contact numbers.
- The After 4 Behaviour Code will be strictly enforced. If a child is asked to sit out in the office more than twice, he/she will **NOT** be allowed to continue in the session. ***Misbehaviour before, during, or after class could result in exclusion from further classes with no refunds given.***
- Parents/caregivers are asked to pick up their child outside the library **promptly at 4:45 pm**. If parents/caregivers are not on time on more than two occasions, the child will no longer be allowed to attend the course. This policy will be strictly enforced. **Please note the dismissal procedure: For safety purposes students must enter the Library and Jamie must check them off the attendance list before they can be released to parents/caregivers. Even students who have permission to walk home on their own must check out with Jamie first. Jamie will escort the Daycare students to the Daycare.**
